Graduate Audition Dates and Procedures

Admission to the program of study for the M.M. in Vocal Performance, the M.A. in Vocal Pedagogy, and the D.M.A. in Vocal Performance degrees will be determined by a live audition before the members of the vocal performance faculty. Taped auditions will not be considered. Acceptance into the program requires a clear majority vote of the audition committee. Applicants who wish to be considered for a University Fellowship must present a live audition on the January audition date. Applicants who wish to be considered for a School of Music Graduate Teaching Associateship (GTA) must (1) audition in person on one of the designated dates prior to March 15; (2) provide a written statement of their voice teaching experience and philosophy; and (3) provide on request a videotaped voice teaching demonstration (minimum of 20 minutes).

M.M. and M.A. Audition Requirements

Applicants must submit a repertoire list representing the scope of their literature and provide programs and reviews (if available) of concerts performed. The program will consist of four pieces that must include a variety of languages and musical styles. One selection should be a recitative and aria from either an opera or an oratorio and one selection should be in English.

D. M. A. Audition Requirements

Applicants must submit a repertoire list representing the scope of their literature and provide programs and reviews (if available) of concerts performed. The audition will consist of a recital program of 40 minutes from which the audition committee will make selections. The program must include a variety of languages and musical styles, and a recitative and aria from either opera or oratorio literature.
