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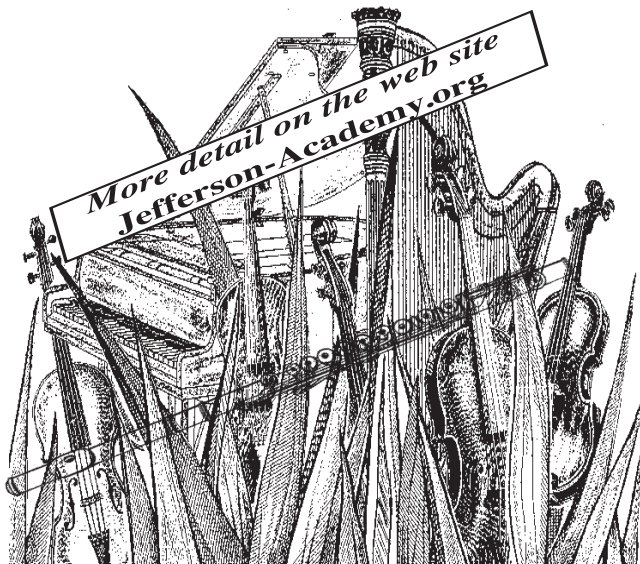

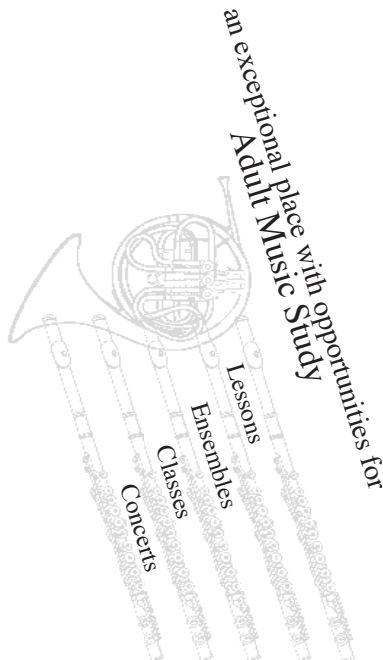

### Why?

**Jefferson @ OSU** believes the musical arts to be an essential and universal language for humanity - and adult learners are no exception. Everyone can experience the pleasure and satisfaction that come from real musical achievement. Whether playing an instrument or singing, whether returning to music or approaching it for the very first time - *it is never too late to pursue this dream.*



### What?

There are opportunities for adults of any age and ability to study music through the **Jefferson @ OSU** programs. Private lessons are available for most instruments and voice. The requirements are a motivation to learn and the personal discipline to apply the techniques presented in classes and lessons during daily practice. Beginners can start piano, voice, or guitar in periodic group classes.



### Where?

**Jefferson @ OSU ~ Academy of Music** schedules all classes and lessons in Hughes and Weigel Halls of the School of Music on the Campus of The Ohio State University. Performances and field trips will take place both on campus and at other locations in the community.



### What else?

Listening is learning too! Registration in all **Jefferson @ OSU** lessons or classes includes complementary admittance to the acclaimed **Jefferson's Signature Series** at the Columbus Museum of Art and School of Music *Concerts On Campus*.



## Group Instruction for Beginners?

There is no greater advantage than setting off in the right direction - whatever the destination may be. **Jefferson @ OSU** has found that for beginners of every age, group instruction under the guidance of an advanced instructor is an ideal and economical way to begin the musical journey. Students learn from each other as well as the instructor. Musicianship topics are integrated into the classes. Students will generally move on to private lessons after a year or two of group instruction.



## Private Lessons?

Individual lessons are available for the study of most orchestral instruments and voice. Experience has shown that progress with the technical aspects of any instrument or voice is accelerated by a broad understanding and appreciation of music in general.

**Jefferson @ OSU** charges no additional fee for concurrent

enroll-

ment in a Musicianship Class and students are urged to participate in a Wednesday class for adults. The length of the weekly lesson is an indication of the minimum daily practice expected. The lesson fees include performance, with a professional accompanist, on Wednesday Studio Soirees & masterclasses.



## Anything else?



Pre-college opportunities available through the program may be of interest to your friends or family. They include Early Childhood & Pre-instrument Classes, Group and Private Lessons, Musicianship, String Project, and Dalcroze Eurhythmics. **Jefferson @ OSU** is open to OSU students who are not music majors, as well as other members of the University community at a 5% discount. ## Who?

Our instructors for adult students are carefully screened and selected on the basis of qualifications, recommendations, experience, and background checks. They have varied credentials and experience - ranging from the Certified Instructor (Level II) who has both a music degree and teaching experience - to the Artist Teacher (Level IV).

## When?

The schedule follows the OSU calendar of two semesters of fifteen weeks each. Both group instruction and Musicianship for adult students meet on Wednesday evenings. Private instruction can be arranged at any day and time that is mutually agreed upon between the instructor and student.

## How much?

There is an annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for each student in **Jefferson @ OSU**.

Tuition/semester for Group Instruction is \$265 + materials.

Tuition/semester for University String Project is \$400 + materials.

Tuition/semester for Private Lessons depends on Instructor Level and the length of the lesson as indicated below:
