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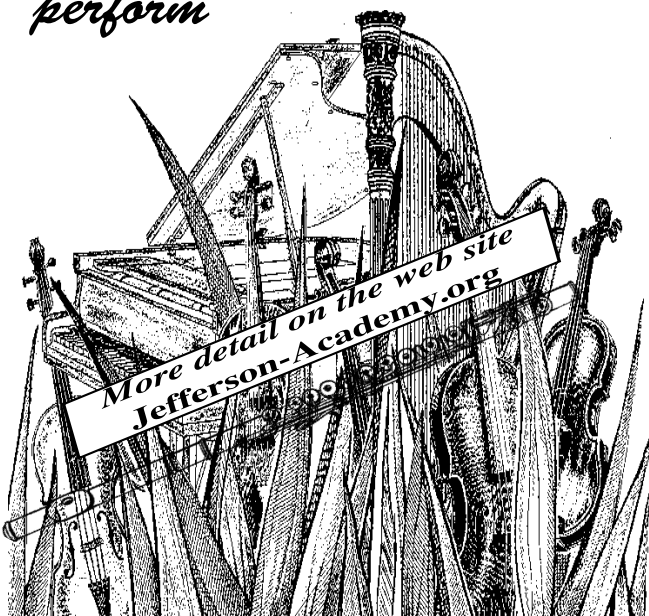

Why?

At **Jefferson @ OSU** we believe the musical arts to be an essential and universal language for humanity. Music depends upon talent, inspiration, and creativity. But, talent without skills, inspiration without knowledge, and creativity without technique and discipline amount to little more than lost potential.



What?

There are opportunities for students of all ages and abilities to study music through the **Jefferson @ OSU** programs. At every level, our instructors are highly qualified and carefully screened.

Private lessons are available for most instruments and voice.

Young beginners can start strings, piano, flute, or guitar in group classes; adult beginners have piano, voice, and guitar.



What else?

Listening is learning too! Registration in all **Jefferson @ OSU** instruction includes admittance, together with one parent, to selected "**Jefferson's Signature Series**" programs on Sunday Afternoons at the Columbus Museum of Art and to OSU School of Music **Concerts On Campus**.



Where?

Jefferson @ OSU ~ Academy of Music schedules all classes and lessons in facilities of the School of Music on the campus of The Ohio State University. Performances and field trips will take place both on campus and at other locations in the community.



Group Instruction for Pre-college Beginners?

There is no greater advantage that setting off in the right direction - whatever the destination may be.

Jefferson @ OSU has found that, for most beginners, group instruction under the guidance of an advanced instructor is the best way to start the musical journey. Students learn from each other as well as the instructor. Musicianship topics are integrated in the classes. Students will generally move on to private lessons after two years in the group. It is essential to have an adequate and properly sized instrument. Please confer with the instructor in order to make the best possible choice.



Private Lessons?

Individual lessons are available for the study of most orchestral instruments and voice. Experience has shown that progress with the technical aspects of any instrument or voice is accelerated by a broader understanding of music in general.

Jefferson at OSU charges no

additional

fee for concurrent enrollment in a Musicianship Class and students are strongly urged to participate in their assigned class. The length of the weekly lesson is an indication of the minimum daily practice expected. The lesson fee includes performance on recitals, masterclasses, and workshops with an accompanist.



What about adults?

Jefferson @ OSU welcomes adults who wish to start, continue, or resume their music study in private lessons. Adult beginners in piano, voice, and guitar also have the option of group instruction in special Wednesday evening classes.



Anything else?

Other opportunities available through **Jefferson @ OSU** include Early Childhood & Pre-instrument Classes, Musicianship, Chamber Music Ensembles, and Dalcroze Eurhythmics. See our current catalog for complete details.

Who?

Our instructors are carefully screened and selected on the basis of qualifications, recommendations, and background checks. They have varied credentials and experience - ranging from the Intern Instructor (Level I) who is just beginning to teach - to the Artist Teacher (Level IV) with graduate music degrees and extensive experience.

When?

The schedule follows the OSU calendar of two semesters of fifteen weeks each. Group classes and Musicianship for pre-college students both meet on Saturday mornings. Private instruction can be arranged at any day and time that is mutually agreed upon between the instructor and student.

How much?

There is an annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for each student in **Jefferson @ OSU**.

Tuition/semester for Group Instruction is \$265 + materials.

Tuition/semester for University String Project is \$400 + materials.

Tuition/semester for Private Lessons depends on Instructor Level and the length of the lesson as indicated below:

*Apprentice Instructors are only available for string lessons and non-adult students.

Provided space is available, all students are accepted. Mail the attached form with non-refundable registration fee, which may be paid by check or credit card. You will also receive the catalog with complete information about **Jefferson @ OSU** programs, together with maps, schedule, and policies.
