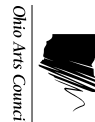

What?

Robert Gillespie, OSU's nationally acclaimed string educator, oversees the **Jefferson @ OSU • University String Project**. It is a unique opportunity for children to study string instruments in a traditional "lab-school" environment. Concurrent instruction in ear training, theory, and eurhythmics are an integral part of the program.



For whom?

The **University String Project** is accepting students in grades 2-7 this school year (beginners only through 5th grade). Students who already play, whether in school programs or otherwise, are assigned to intermediate and advanced classes, depending on technical and reading skills. Small ensembles and private lessons are added to higher levels. The **University String Project** is a great complement to school programs.



When?

Jefferson @ OSU follows The Ohio State University academic calendar, which changes from quarters to semesters in summer 2012. The 15-week fall semester of this year's **University String Project** classes will meet for two-hours each Saturday mornings, starting on Aug. 25.
