The OSU School of Music **ConcertCard** is the pinnacle of concert passes! Support the School of Music with the purchase of this special card, which allows admission for up to six people to all concerts in Weigel and Hughes Auditoriums, all year long.

If you purchase a **ConcertCard**, you will also receive additional discounts to events held in Mershon Auditorium, to School of Music events held in CAPA theatres, and to Ohio State Theatre and Dance events. Simply mention your **ConcertCard** when calling the box office.\*

**ConcertCards** are \$100 and are available for advance purchase, with a credit card, by calling (614) 292-7258. **ConcertCards** may also be purchased at the Weigel box office one hour prior to any concert (cash or check only). Once you have purchased your **ConcertCard**, tickets for individual performances may be reserved in advance by calling this same number or picked up at the Weigel box office one hour before the performance. Subject to availability.

\* Please note: The Marching Band concert at Veterans Memorial on Nov. 11, 2012 is not included in the Card program.

## CONCERT PARKING

Convenient parking is available at three locations close to the School of Music. The **Arps Garage** is located at 1990 College Rd., just one block north of Weigel and Hughes Halls. Enter from College Rd. Parking is also available at the **Ohio Union North and South Garages**, just a short distance south of Weigel Hall. ### Are tickets available at the door?

If an event is not sold out, yes, tickets will also be available at the event venue box office one hour prior to the performance. Keep in mind that many events sell out, so advance purchase and/or pick-up is advised! Tickets purchased at the door at the Weigel Auditorium Box Office – cash or check only!

### What is Reserved Seating?

Events marked with **RSVD** are reserved seating, which means you have a specific seat assigned. If you wish seats together, all tickets must be obtained at the same time! All other events are general admission and you select your seat when you arrive.

### How can I obtain my FREE ticket with my BuckID?

Free tickets are limited to one per BuckID, which must be presented to receive a ticket. No exceptions. Free tickets are not available for advance order over the phone.
