About Michael Murray

Michael Murray was trained in Paris by Marcel Dupré. He began his career by performing the complete works of Bach in 12 recitals in Cleveland in 1968–69. He has given solo recitals in nearly every major city in America and in numerous musical centers throughout the world. He has appeared as soloist with the Chicago Symphony, Philadelphia Orchestra, San Francisco Symphony, Atlanta Symphony, Royal Philharmonic, and Columbus Symphony, among others. His 29 recordings for Telarc are among the classical music industry's worldwide best-sellers. This June he will retire as organist at Saint Mark's, where he has played since 1983.
