<sup>3</sup> Six (6) ensemble registrations (1 credit minimum each) on the principal instrument must be taken over a period of 6 semesters. All take one chamber or small ensemble (1 credit minimum) as approved by the music education faculty advisor. Voice and keyboard principals must add one ensemble elective.

<sup>4</sup> Piano principals take 2200.21 instead.

<sup>5</sup> Music 2470 is offered in both autumn and spring. It is fundamental to Professional Standing in music education and serves as the second GE writing course.

<sup>6</sup> Serves as GE open-option course.

<sup>7</sup> Open-option courses can be selected from any of the following: Another GE-approved course, a service learning course, a cross-disciplinary seminar, or education abroad.

<sup>8</sup> Music 2244 has no prerequisites and typically is taught in the spring. It may be taken in any year.
