The Arianna String Quartet, firmly established as one of America’s premiere chamber ensembles, is consistently hailed for their outstanding musicianship. The group was founded twenty years ago and soon won the Coleman, Carmel, and Fischhoff competitions. That was followed by being designated Laureates of France’s Bordeaux International String Quartet Competition. The Quartet, which previously held the Ensemble-in-Residence position at the Tanglewood Music Center, has recorded for major labels throughout their career. They have been heard in live broadcasts on Canada’s CBC, National Public Radio’s Performance Today, and Japan’s national network.

The concert will introduce Central Ohio to the chamber music of Gabriela Lena Frank, a gifted young composer who is also “something of a musical anthropologist.” Inspired by the research and music of Bela Bartók, she has dug into her own multicultural heritage to find a voice both distinctly her own, yet hauntingly familiar. A serious illness left her with impaired hearing and sight, but Frank’s muse had already filled her head with musical ideas. They have taken form in a series of prestigious commissions and representation by a distinguished publisher. Frank’s string quartet, Leyendas: An Andean Walkabout, coalesces her roots and research into a representative sample of her oeuvre.
